## High School Registration 2009

The El Dorado Union High School District has released the following student registration information for the 2009–10 school year. School will start on August 10, 2009. Consult your respective school's website for the starting times of your school.

**EL DORADO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

The Counseling Office will be closed for summer break from June 15 to July 10, reopening on July 13 for pickup or drop-off of information. Counseling Office hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (closed during lunch hour from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m.). Counselors, however, will not be available until July 29.

**New students** may register without a Counselor from July 20 through August 5. Materials will be available on-line on the school's web site. Counselors will be available by appointment from July 29 through August 5. Students may call ahead for an appointment time. New Student Orientation will take place on August 6 in the Large Gym from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. Parent Orientation will start at 6:15 p.m. Students are reminded to have their transcript, immunization information, and proof of residence (voter registration, driver's license address change, PG&E bill, etc.) available at the time of registration.

For **returning students**, information packets will be mailed home by request, or can be picked up in the Counseling Office during the summer when the office is open. Schedule changes will not be accepted unless the change involves a course required for graduation. Requests for elective changes will not be accepted. All students must follow the class schedule they receive on the first day of school. Students may pick up their schedule on August 3, between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. in front of the school's main office in exchange for a completed emergency card. Students who do not pick up their schedule on August 3 can turn in their completed emergency card and pick up their schedule on the first day of school between 7:30 and 8:25 a.m. in front of the Large Gym.

### OAK RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

### PONDEROSA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

**New student** registration is by appointment only.
