G. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES – ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Local Indicators for the California School Dashboard. (10)

State data is not available for some priority areas identified in the Local Control Funding Formula law. For these priority areas, the State Board of Education approved the local indicators, which are based on information that local educational agencies collect locally. The local indicators are:

- Basic Services
- Implementation of State Academic Standards
- Parent Engagement
- School Climate

Local educational agencies receive one of three ratings based on whether they have measured and reported their progress through the Dashboard using locally collected data. The ratings are: Met, Not Met, or Not Met for Two or More Years.

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the local indicator rating of "Met" for Basic Services, Implementation of State Academic Standards, Parent Engagement, and School Climate.

H. BUSINESS SERVICES – ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. <u>10 Year Enrollment History and 6 Year Enrollment Projection from School Years 2017/18 to</u> 2024/25. (25)

Every year after CBEDS enrollments are compiled, new enrollment projections are calculated based on the most current data available. SchoolWorks, Inc. has prepared a Demographic Study for the 10-year enrollment history and 6 year enrollment projections from 2017/18 to 2023/24.

The study provides a one-year projection detail by grade level and school and a 6-year projection summary by school with 10 years of historical data. These projections are used to determine staffing and facility needs. El Dorado Union High School District is projected to increase enrollment by 1.2% (or 79 students) for the 2018/2019 school year. The District is projected to remain fairly flat over the next six years with a projected enrollment of 6,776 students in 2023/24 school year. This is a total growth of 102 students, which is an increase of 1.5%. The projections are predicated upon information provided by local municipalities on the development of 3,877 housing units over the next six years. SchoolWorks, Inc. will present the study to the Board.

The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the 2017/18 Demographic Study.

I. STUDENT SERVICES – ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. <u>Limited Open Enrollment for Union Mine High School for 2018-2019.</u> (10)

According to California Education Code, a school district is to allow students to attend a school that is not already at its student capacity. The El Dorado Union High School District uses a variety of factors to determine the capacity levels for each of our comprehensive high schools.

Based on capacity factors, current enrollment and projected enrollments, it is recommended that the District implement the limited open enrollment process for Union Mine High School for 2018-2019. It is further recommended that, based on current and projected enrollments, we make available 35 openings for the purpose of open enrollment for Union Mine High School for the 2018-2019 school year. If the District receives more open enrollment transfer requests than openings available, a random, non-biased selection process will be used to determine students who will receive a transfer.

District Administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the implementation of the limited open enrollment process at Union Mine High School for the 2018-2019 school year.
