 - 2018 Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment Results for English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Quick Summary/Abstract:

The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) for English language arts/literacy and mathematics are based on California's goal of preparing students for college and career. English language arts and mathematics student performance is measured using the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments. The purpose of the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments is to measure what students know, can do, and how much students have improved. These measures help identify and address gaps in knowledge or skills so students get the support they need to become ready for college or a career.

All students in grade eleven take the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments unless a student's active individualized education program (IEP) designates the California Alternate Assessments.

The Smarter Balanced Assessments are computer adaptive tests that adjust the difficulty of questions on the basis of the answers students give. As students answer correctly, they receive more challenging questions. Incorrect answers trigger easier questions. This approach helps keep students engaged, shortens testing time for many students, and provides more accurate results, especially for low-or high-achieving students.

The results give the district one measure of how well students are mastering California's challenging academic standards. The skills called for by these standards—the ability to write clearly, think critically, and solve problems—are critical for preparing students for college and a 21st-century career.

The California State University (CSU) and participating California Community Colleges use the CAASPP ELA and mathematics assessments to determine students' 2018 Early Assessment Program status. The CAASPP achievement levels for ELA and mathematics can be used to provide an early indicator of students' readiness for college-level coursework, as described:

- Standard Exceeded: Ready for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework.
- Standard Met: Conditionally Ready for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework. Students earning this status can be exempt from the CSU's placement test and Early Start Program by taking an approved course and earning a grade of C or better.
- Standard Nearly Met: Not yet demonstrating readiness for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework.
- Standard Not Met: Not demonstrating readiness for English and/or mathematics college-level coursework.
