G. BUSINESS SERVICES - ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. 10 Year Enrollment History and 6 Year Enrollment Projection from School Years 2018/19 to 2025/26 Every year after CALPADS enrollments are compiled and new enrollment projections are calculated based on the most current data available. SchoolWorks, Inc. has prepared a Demographic Study for the 10-year period from 2018/19 to 2025/26.

The study provides a one-year projection detail by grade level and school and a 10-year projection summary by school with 10 years of historical data. These projections are used to determine staffing and facility needs.

SchoolWorks, Inc. will present the study to the Board.

The Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the Demographic Study Report.

2. Anti-Tobacco Grant Funding/Reimbursement Agreement.

The County of El Dorado applied for the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Act of 2016/Prop 56 Tobacco Tax Grant fund program. The County was awarded grant funds in the amount of \$924,085 for the fiscal year 2018-19 and 2019-20 grant, which provides funding for investigation and enforcement efforts to abate tobacco product use and vaping by minors. The County will receive the grant funds, purchase and loan equipment to education institutes, or reimburse agencies who purchase grant approved equipment.

The El Dorado Union High School District is eligible to receive Prop 56 Tobacco Tax program fund, and the county has agreed to disburse an amount not to exceed \$54,575 on the grant funds to EDUHSD as reimbursement for the installation of Vape Sensors.

The El Dorado Union High School District will use the funds to be reimbursed by the County solely for the project and will work directly with the supplier on the installation of the project.

The Administration recommends that that the Board of Trustees approve the MOU Funding/Reimbursement Agreement with County.

H. STUDENT SERVICES AND INNOVATION - ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Limited Open Enrollment at El Dorado and Union Mine High Schools.

According to California Education Code, a school district is to allow students to attend a school that is not already at its student capacity. The El Dorado Union High School District uses a variety of factors to determine the capacity levels for each of our comprehensive high schools.

Based on capacity factors, current enrollment and projected enrollments, it is recommended that the District implement the Limited Open Enrollment process for both El Dorado High School and Union Mine High School for the 2020-2021 school year. It is further recommended that, based on current and projected enrollments, we make available 35 openings at El Dorado and 35 openings at Union Mine High School for the purpose of Open Enrollment for the 2020-2021 school year. If the District receives more Open Enrollment application requests than openings available, a random, non-biased selection process will be used to determine students who will receive a transfer.

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the implementation fo the Limited Open Enrollment process at El Dorado and Union Mine High Schools for the 2020-2021 school year.
