➤➤ **Included in the packet is the Course Selection Form.** This form is your student's *ticket* for classes and for the class schedule to be created. Based on what grade level you are, your counselor will review and evaluate your previous academic record to confirm placement in classes.

Graduation Requirements

High school is 4 years long and to graduate from Ponderosa High School you must earn 220* credits to meet the graduation requirements.

*Recently reduced 20 credits due to COVID-19 impact

1 year long class = 10 credits

6 classes x 10 credits = 60 credits

9th and 10th grade students must complete 60 credits per year, totaling 120 credits after 10th grade.
