## **Career Technical Education**

From Computer Science to Cosmetology, the El Dorado Union High School District offers 53 Career Technical Education (CTE) courses that help students prepare for the world of work. The courses are arranged by industry sectors and pathways to students explore career fields and sequence training. The CTE facilities have been upgraded using Measure Q, Career Pathways Trust Grant, Career Technical Education Incentive Grant and Perkins Grant funds. Some CTE courses are articulated with local community colleges, enabling students to earn college credit while in high school. In addition, these articulated courses make it easier for students to complete community college CTE certifications.
