I know the future holds great promise because EDUHSD will continue to provide the highest-quality educational programs and facilities for our students."

"The work Chris has invested in our educators and employees will benefit our students for many years to come," said EDUHSD Board President Kevin Brown. "He came to us and enhanced our existing programs, initiated new and innovative projects and has become a dear friend and fixture in our community. He will be missed, but I know he will bring great things to the students of Elk Grove."
