At the regularly scheduled EDUHSD Board Meeting on Tuesday, September 22nd, the Board of Trustees will make a decision on whether the District returns to inperson instruction under the hybrid model and is seeking parent/guardian input. The hybrid schedule is a model in which students attend school for in person instruction two days each week. Students will be scheduled into Cohort A or Cohort B. When on campus, cohorts will follow the full day bell schedule. When cohorts are at home, they will have asynchronous/independent work and the possibility of joining webcasts or recordings of lessons from home. Your site will be sending out more specifics on the schedule.

The health and safety of students and staff is the top priority when making the decision to physically reopen school campuses. Safety protocols and procedures will be in place and will be detailed in later communication and our plans are on our website. We are subject to the guidance of the California Department of Public Health and will require students to wear masks as a condition of attendance, consistent with all schools in California, and therefore we will need your support. If students have an underlying condition that precludes them not wearing face coverings a physician's note will be required.

The purpose of the attached survey is to gather information from families as we consider possible scenarios for returning to classrooms for in-person instruction.
