Dear EDUHSD Student and Parent/Guardian(s),

On August 3, 2020, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released the most updated version of *COVID-19 Industry Guidance: Schools and School-Based Programs* that outlined implementation expectations for reopening schools in the face of the COVID-19 health crisis. The guidelines are based on the best available public health data, international best practices currently employed, and the practical realities of managing school operations. Key ingredients to fighting COVID-19 is preventing the spread, which includes:

- Masks are required except when eating or drinking
- Physical distancing of 6 feet or more
- Washing your hands with soap and water or using 60% ethyl alcohol hand sanitizer
- Self-checking staff and student symptoms, prior to coming to school each day by completing the online [Home Covid-19 Daily Symptom Check-In](#) form. This form opens in a browser window so you can bookmark it for easy reference.
- Making sure individuals do not come to school if they have COVID-19 symptoms or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

Our staff, in consultation with the El Dorado Public Health Department and community experts, has worked diligently over the summer to plan for school reopening.

We all must do our part to maintain a healthy school environment. As a result of CDPH guidelines, when students return to campus we will be asking students or parents and school staff to self-check their symptoms prior to coming to school every day. The information will be recorded electronically and confidentially. Alternatively, a paper form may be accessed at our district website under health services. If any of the questions on the symptom checker are answered YES, please keep your child home and contact your site School Nurse listed below. Students who have not had their symptoms checked may be assessed by health personnel on campus. Should you have any questions please feel free to contact your site nurse at their office number listed below.
