Voluntary, Rapid and / or PCR COVID-19 Testing Opportunities

The health and safety of our community is of paramount importance to the El Dorado Union High School District. People within our school community shared that they were having trouble securing rapid tests in a timely and convenient manner (many testing locations are a significant geographic distance for families). With the support of our partners, we were able to solve this problem.

This testing resource helps reduce student quarantines and the potential spread of the virus. Timely testing is imperative to our ability to keep students and staff safely in school. As mentioned, this is an outside parking lot with drive-thru service and no individuals are on campus outside their vehicles.

The testing site offers free drive-thru Rapid Antigen and/or PCR COVID-19 testing.

Testing is facilitated outdoors in the southernmost section of the lower parking lot. Members of the community pursuing a COVID-19 test are required to drive through for testing and wear a mask/face covering in accordance with California State guidelines. Members of the public are not allowed on school grounds and must remain in their vehicle during testing.
