Alternative College Preparatory Online Options for the 2021-2022 School Year

The El Dorado Union High School District created a distance-learning program to accommodate families due to challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. This program combines live synchronous teaching via Zoom and traditional independent study courses using Apex Learning or Edgenuity software. Next year, we plan to continue this program for interested families.

Students will be considered enrolled at their school of residence, but will take classes virtually. They will be eligible to participate in sports and extracurricular activities at their school of residence. Attached to this notification is an enrollment form with additional information on the Online Distance Learning Program for the 2021-22 school year. Enrollment is limited. Therefore, enrollment will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment forms are due to the Counseling Office by Friday, February 19, 2021.

In addition, the District manages the Virtual Academy, which is a college preparatory charter school. The school provides students either a full-time in-person or a hybrid-learning program. This program also offers an early college high school option, where students take community college courses while in high school, with some courses offered at the charter school and others on the Folsom Lake College campus. Students enrolled in the Virtual Academy charter school may also participate in athletics at the traditional high school associated with their residential address.
