Announcing El Dorado Union High School District's New COVID-19 Dashboard

We are eager to share information regarding our District's "COVID-19 Dashboard" with you. We know that there is a lot of information being distributed from a variety of sources regarding schools and COVID-19. We will provide you with pertinent data about our schools in a transparent and efficient manner, while protecting the confidentiality of impacted individuals. Therefore, following the models of public health departments and other school districts, we have created a District "COVID-19 Dashboard". The dashboard contains numbers of positive students/staff cases and numbers of students/staff in quarantine at each of our sites. Please recognize that information regarding COVID-19 cases and related quarantines is fluid and changes frequently throughout the day. We plan to publish information at our disposal to the dashboard each day around 5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday (excluding school breaks).

Please note that we will no longer be sending out global messages for each identified positive case at your school site. Rather, we ask that you refer to the dashboard for daily updates relating to changes in COVID-19 rates in our schools. Our goal is to provide you with information without inundating you with messaging. Contact tracing will continue and impacted individuals will receive communication in accordance with protocol prescribed by the California Department of Public Health.

We are grateful for your ongoing collaboration and cooperation as we navigate these challenging times.
