New Online Distance Learning Program

The El Dorado Union High School District is working closely with the El Dorado County Public Health Department to finalize our plan for reopening schools this fall. In-person instruction is scheduled to resume on Monday, August 10, 2020 at all schools. The conditions in which schools reopen will be based on the recommendations and requirements set forth by Dr. Nancy Williams, El Dorado County's Public Health Officer. The Board of Trustees and Superintendent Ron Carruth will release the reopening planning document shortly and make a formal announcement regarding school openings on Wednesday, July 22, 2020.

In addition, the District recognizes that students and/or members of students' households may be vulnerable and more at risk for COVID-19. Therefore, the District created a new Online Distance Learning Program designed to provide those students with a quality education, while maintaining maximum social distancing.
