2020/21 Summer School Program Update

The District remains committed to offering families educational options as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. We are excited to announce that we will be offering a District-wide 2020/21 Summer School Program this year at Ponderosa High School (3661 Ponderosa Road, Shingle Springs). Classes will begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Nutrition Services will continue to provide one free breakfast and one free lunch daily to all students throughout the duration of summer school. Meals will be available before school as well as during break in the cafeteria.

The Transportation Department will run bus services in the following areas: Oak Ridge High School, Serrano Parkway, Valley View, Bass Lake, La Canada, Union Mine High School, Bucks Bar & Mt. Aukum Rd. at the dirt lot, Pleasant Valley School, Pollock Pines Safeway, Camion Post Office, Camino Heights Park & Ride, El Dorado High School, Placerville Boys and Girls Club, Mosquito Transit Station and Greenstone Park & Ride. Students will be taught by credentialed teachers. The original course grade and summer session grade received shall be entered on the student's transcript, but the student shall receive credit only once for taking the course. The highest grade received shall be used in determining the student's overall grade point average (GPA). Summer school courses will be for remediation, not acceleration.

First Semester Curriculum: June 10 to June 30, 2021
Registration Due: April 23, 2021

Second Semester Curriculum: July 1 to July 22, 2021
Registration Due: May 28, 2021

Families must complete an application form and submit it to their student's guidance counselor to enroll in the program. Please click on the attached 2020/21 EDUHSD Summer School Student Enrollment Form, which includes courses offered and program descriptions.

The District anticipates with a high level of confidence that we will be able to offer all of the classes listed on the application form. If however, we cannot, we will contact students and families as soon as possible.
