El Dorado Union High School District Community,

We are all aware that the COVID-19 Delta variant is resulting in more positive cases in our local community and many people are concerned about potential exposure. The schools are experiencing positive cases consistent with increased numbers in the community, similar to what we experienced last year. We will be implementing a weekly update to our [Dashboard](#) to keep everyone informed of the positive cases.

We are also pursuing opportunities for COVID-19 testing for members of our learning community. These are voluntary opportunities to assist individuals who may be concerned about possible exposure so that we can help keep our community healthy.

We are pleased to announce that voluntary rapid testing is available through our partners at the El Dorado Community Health Center. They will be able to accommodate COVID-19 testing for students from our schools at the sites below:
