

Application Filing Period December 1-15, 2023

Online Distance Learning Program

The El Dorado Union High School District continues to offer a full-time distance learning program for the 2023-2024 school year. Limited spaces remain available for the Spring term. Families who prefer distance learning or have health and safety concerns may apply to ODLP. Application period is December 1-15. Families will be notified of enrollment or wait list status before winter break. Distance learning may require more parental engagement and monitoring than traditional schooling.

Daily attendance to "Live" classes is mandatory. Students who do not attend these classes will be exited from ODLP and will return to on campus classes. Students identified for SART or SARB may not apply to ODLP.

ON-CAMPUS COURSE ENROLLMENT

The distance learning program is being offered to provide families with the opportunity to attend regularly scheduled teacher led classes from home each day in parallel with online independent study courses. In rare instances, a student may access an on-campus in-person course. Priority for on-campus courses is given to students attending the high school daily.

ASSESSMENT S:

Teachers are assessing students via the Learning Management System, Google Classroom.

Electives are assessed in either APEX or Edgenuity.

GRADING:

Students shall be assigned letter grades.

Curriculum:

Students receive direct instruction via zoom 5 days a week for English, Mathematics, Science and Social Science courses. Teacher created content is shared using Google Classroom as the learning management system. Teachers utilize Board adopted curriculum, supplemental resources, and online tools to communicate with students including video postings, live webinars, and video conferences.

Independent Study/Online Courses

For all other courses, students will have the opportunity to select from Board approved APEX or Edgenuity courses. These courses are online, text based platforms. Printed packet options will not be provided. A teacher facilitator will monitor student progress.

AP course offerings are completed via APEX or Edgenuity.

Students in need shall be provided Chromebooks and hotspots from their school of residence.

Athletics/Extra-Curricular

Programs:Students participating in the Online Distance Learning Program remain enrolled at their school of residence. Students are eligible to participate in athletics or after school extracurricular activities affiliated with the school following school procedures and regulations.
